





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Goldish GRAPHING



Supplies: Colored Goldfish crackers or fish candies, crayons, Goldfish graphing sheet

Directions:

- I. Print the graphing sheet.
- 2. Look at the colored fish crackers or candies and find a crayon that matches each color.
- 3. Use these colors to color the fish on the bottom of the graphing page.
- 4. Take a handful of fish crackers/candies and sort by color.
- 5. Place the fish on the graph in the column that matches each fish's color.
- 6. Discuss information you can learn from the graph such as:

 How many fish in are there in each column? Which column has the most?

Which column has the least? How many more red than green, etc.

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
