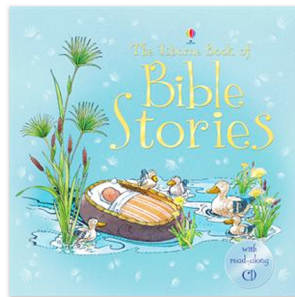

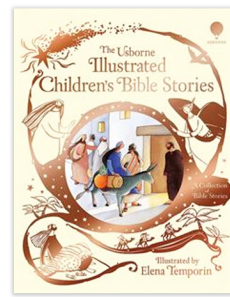

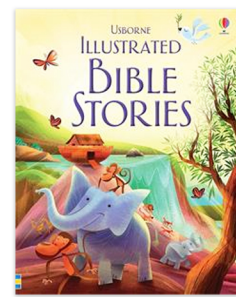
Moms and teachers are always asking for Bible reader recommendations, and I have a few suggestions!

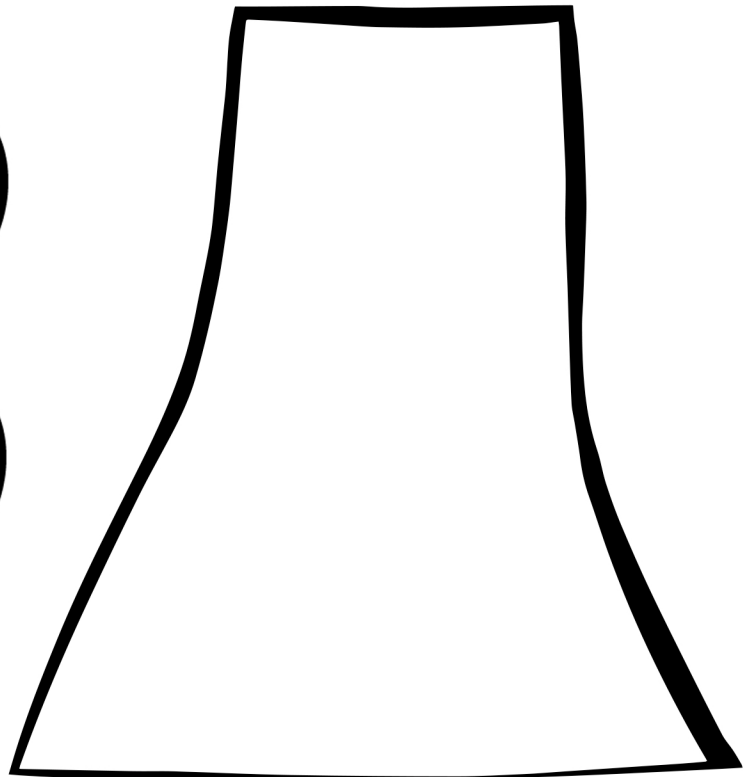
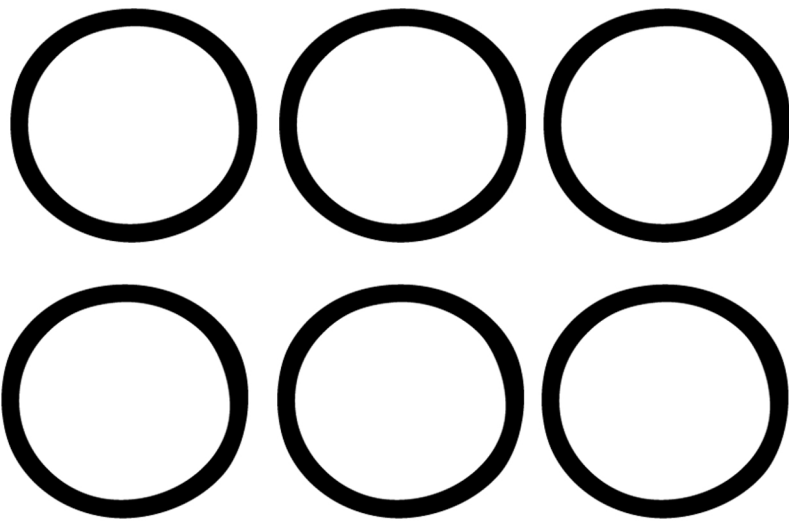
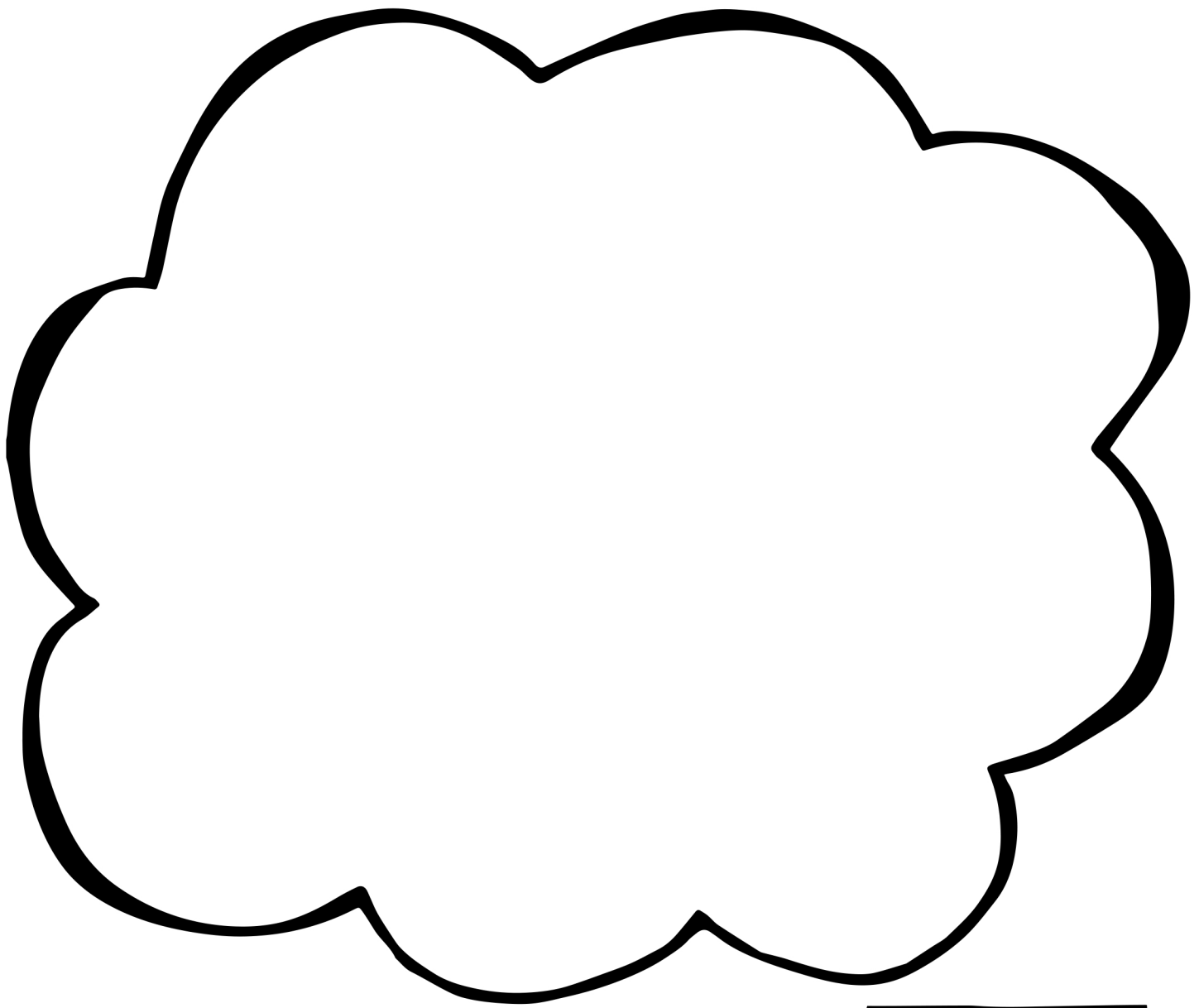


Fruit Tree Template

Recreate fruit trees from the Garden of Eden with a fun craft!



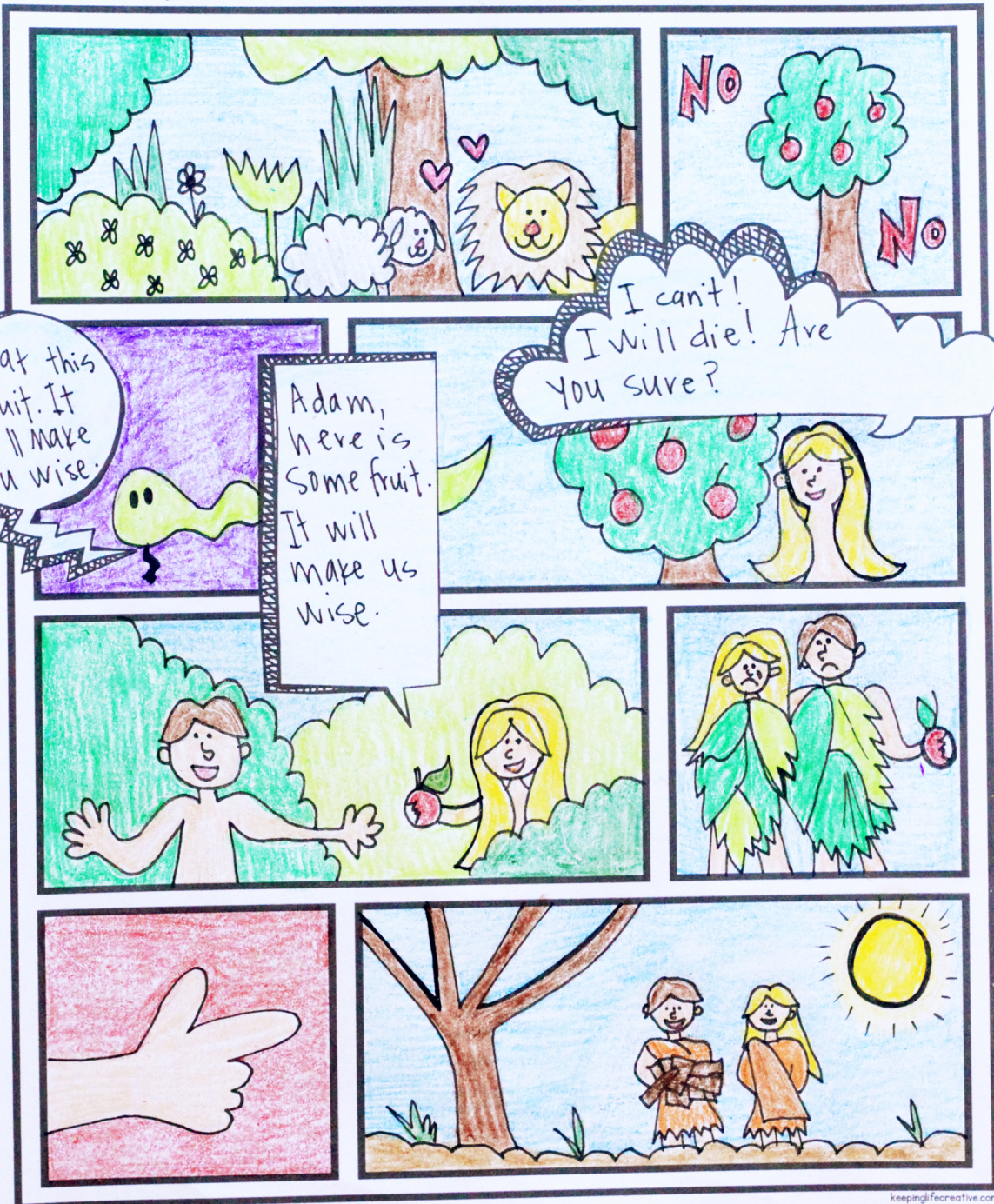
1. Print template; paint or color.

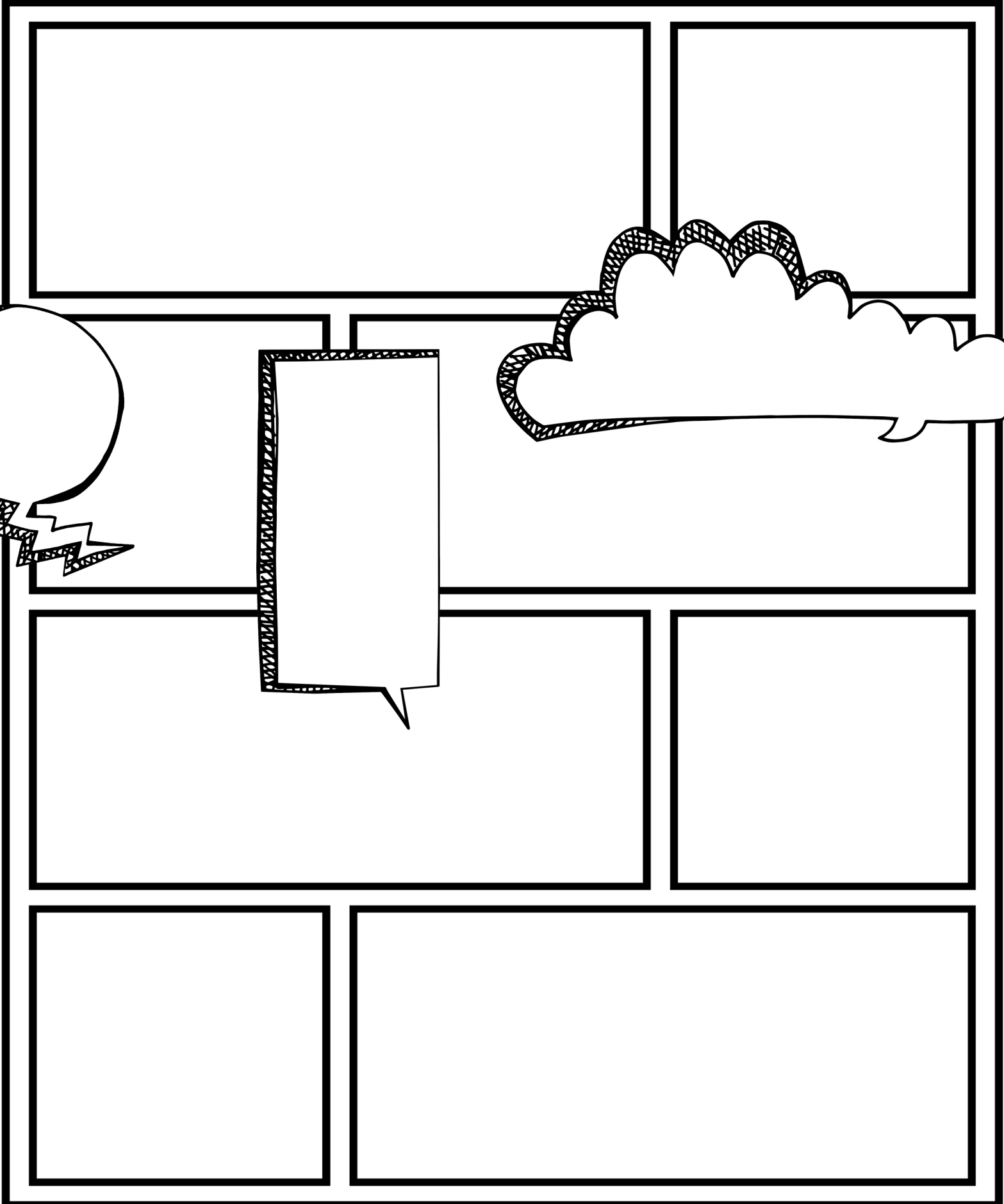

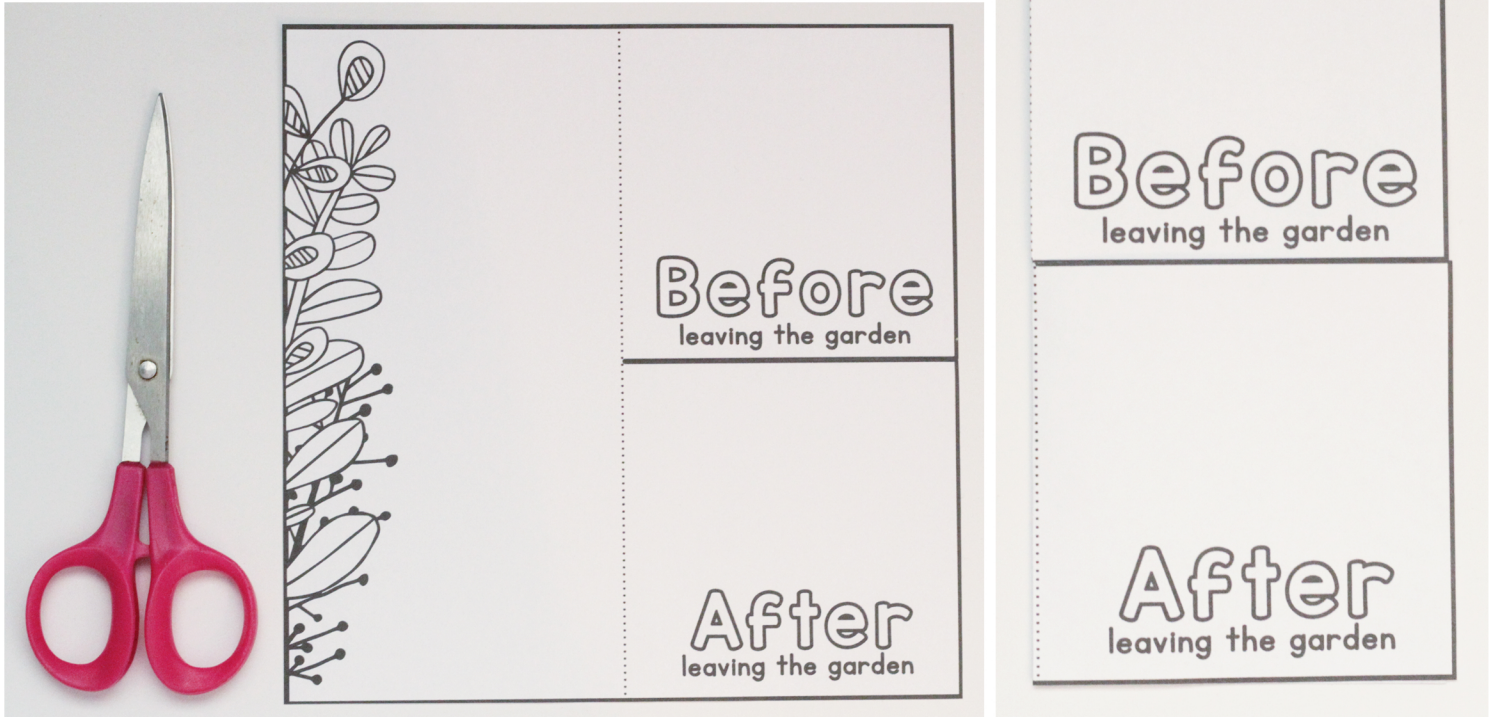

2. Cut apart cards.

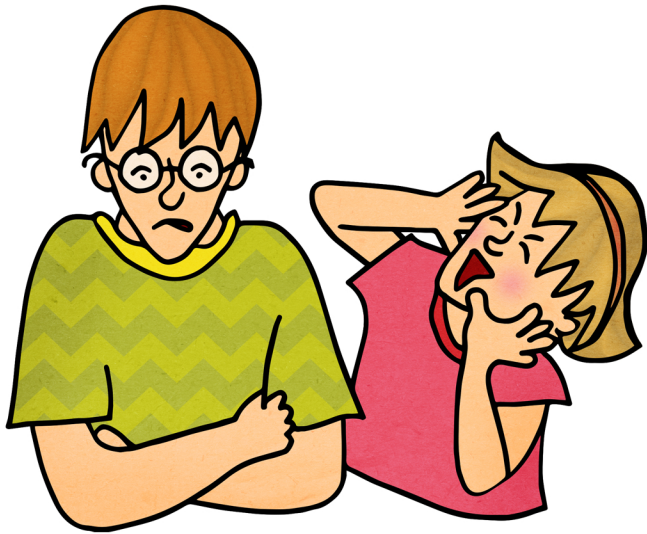


3. Discuss the choice represented in each picture.

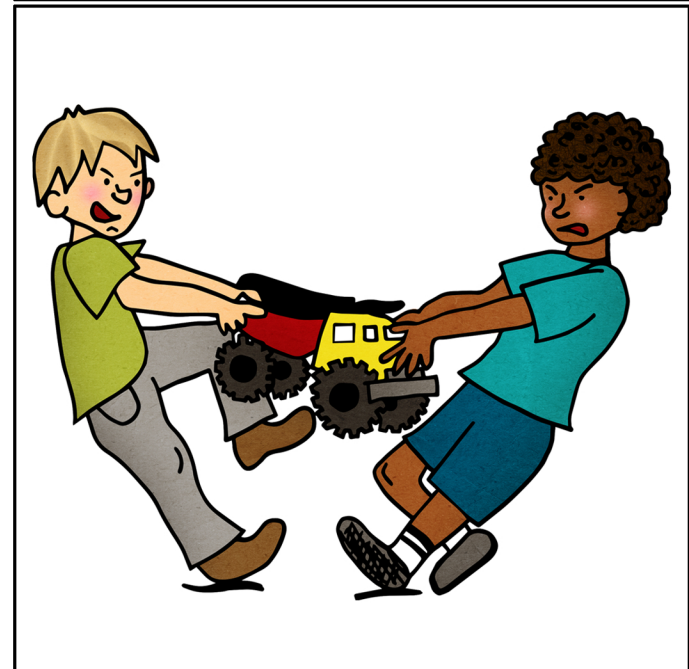
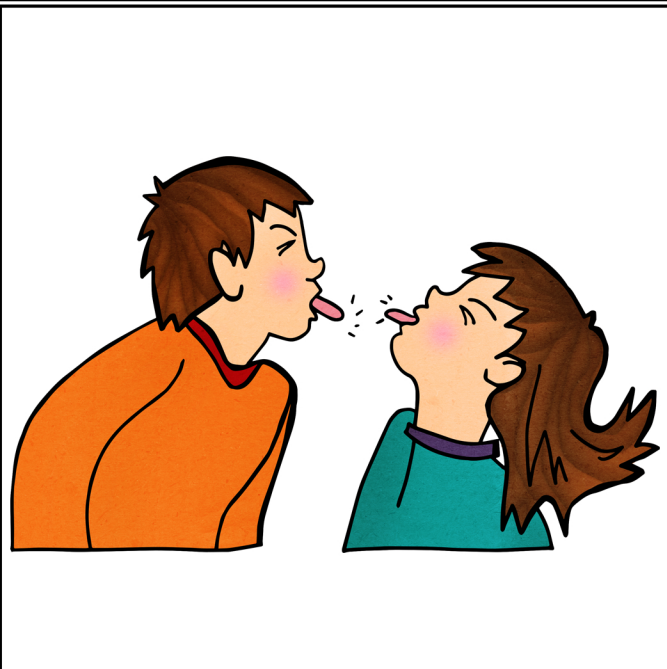
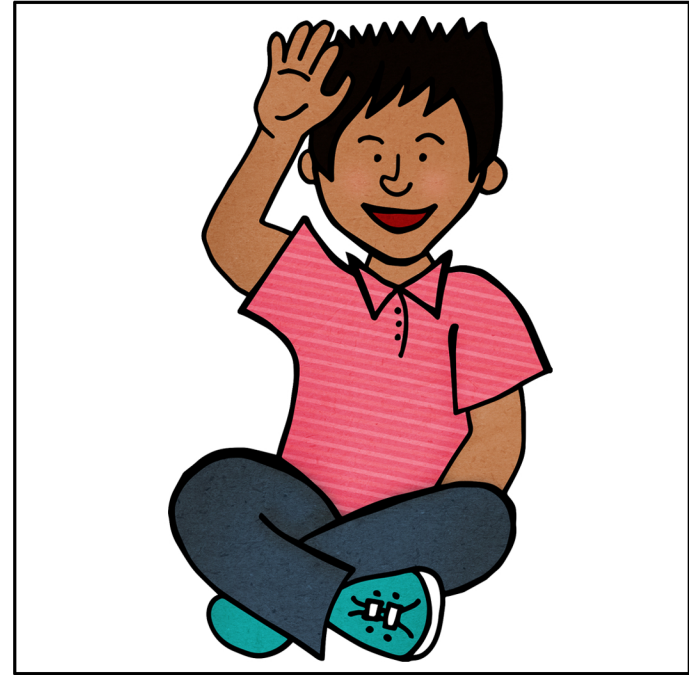
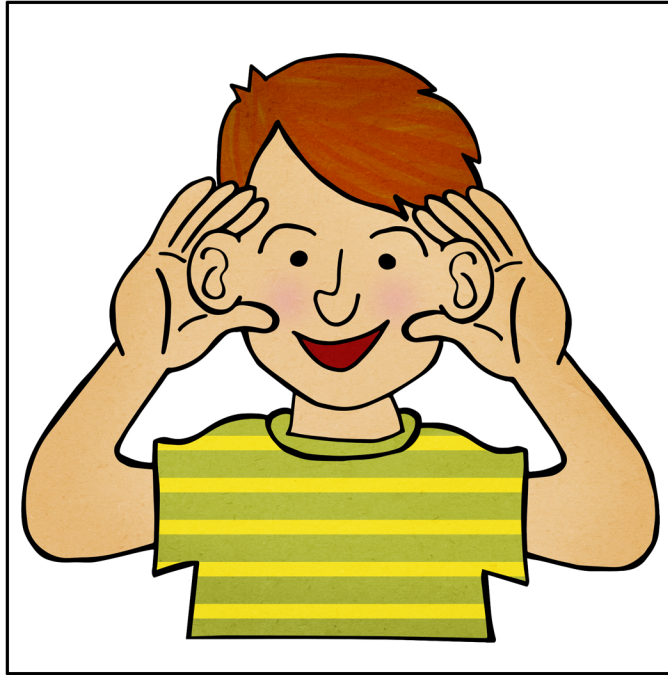
4. Sort the cards into “good” or “bad” choices.
