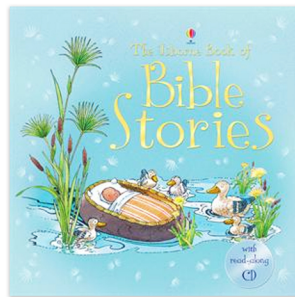

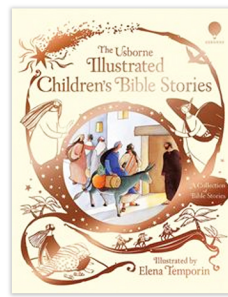

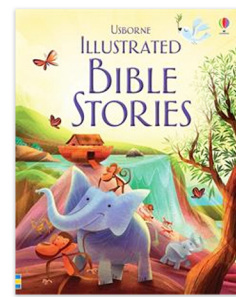
Moms and teachers are always asking for Bible reader recommendations, and I have a few suggestions!

Print on t-shirt transfer paper, iron on felt, and use on a flannel board.

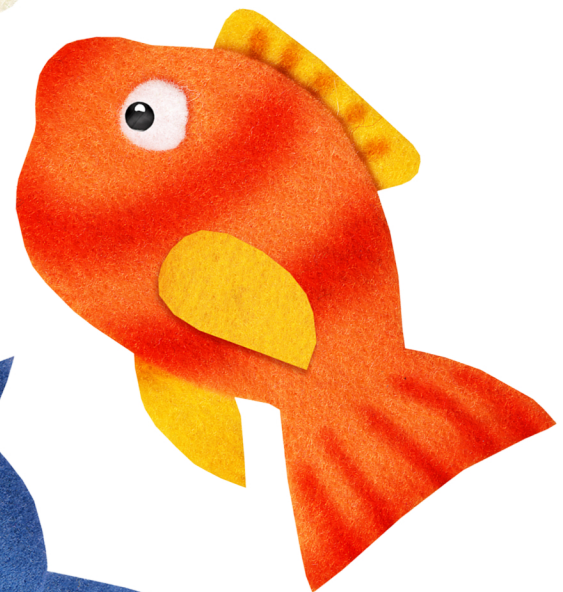
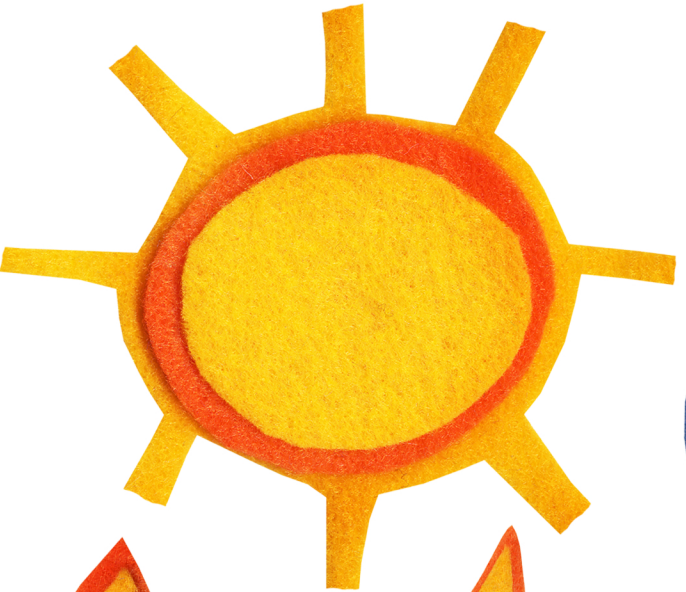
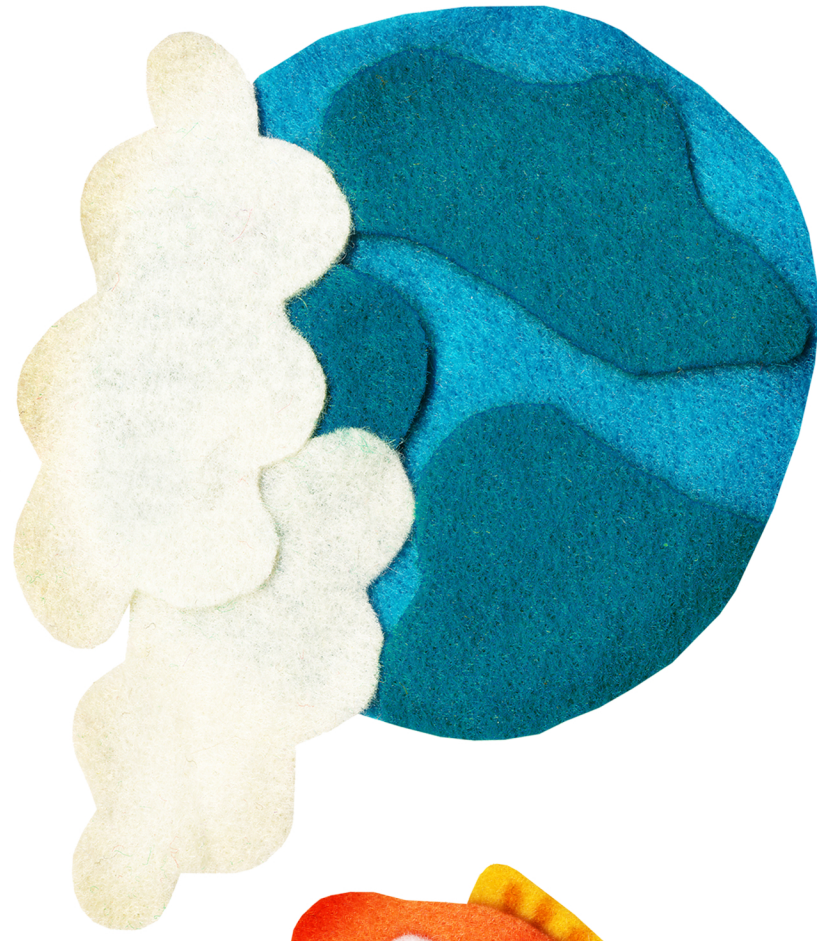
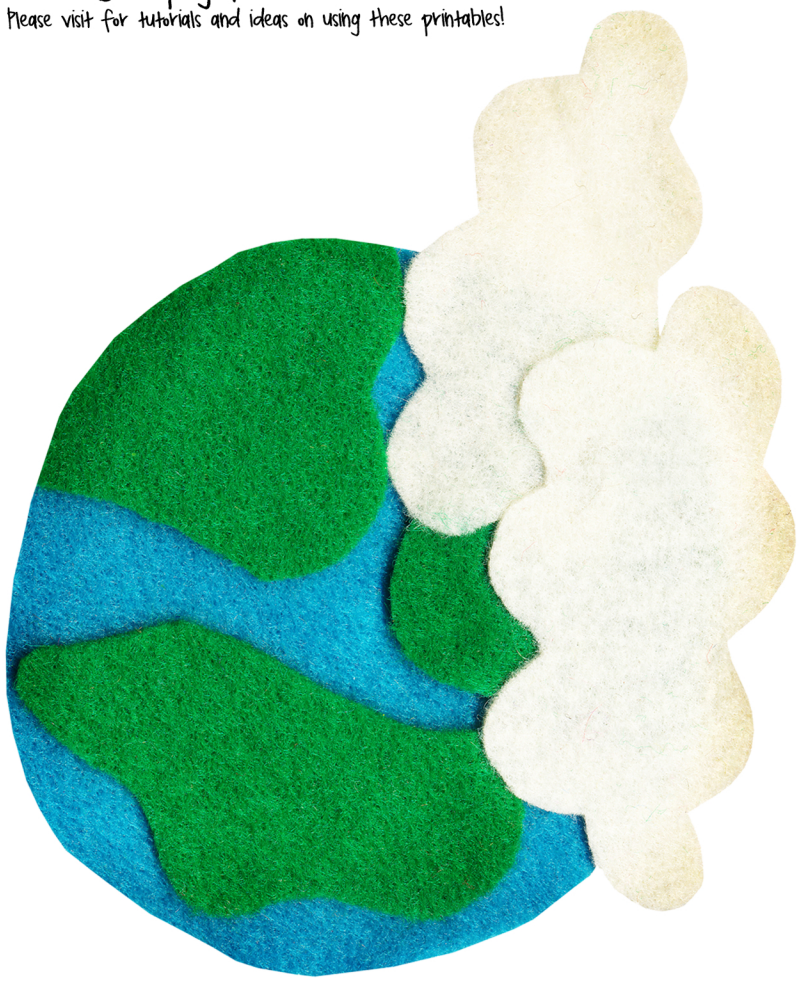
Print on cardstock, laminate, glue a magnet to back, and use on magnet board.

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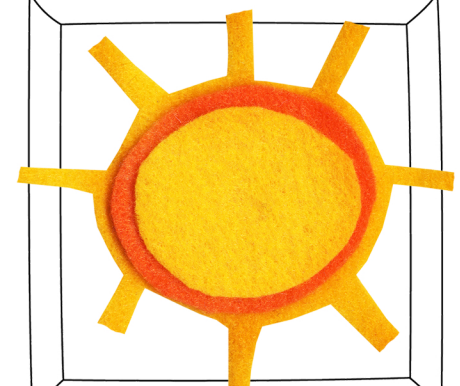
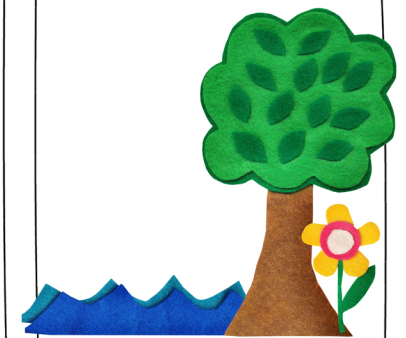
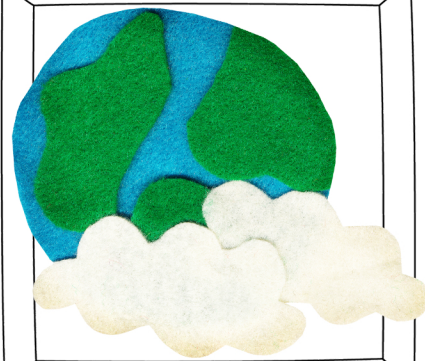
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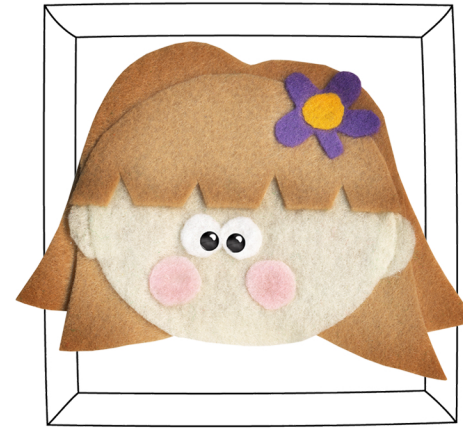
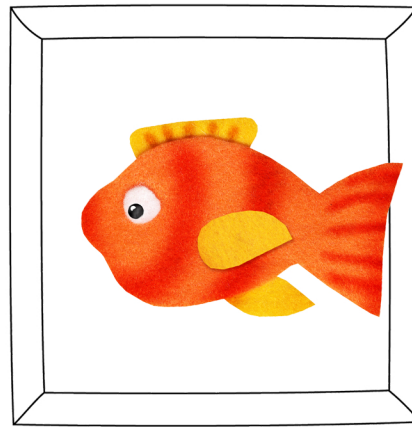
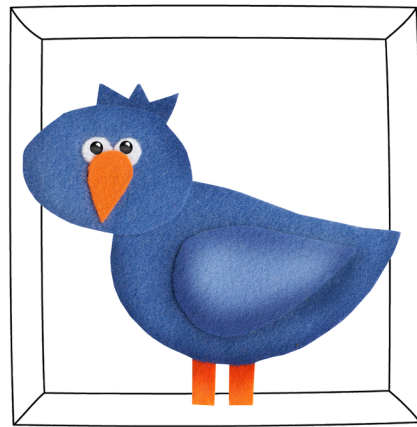
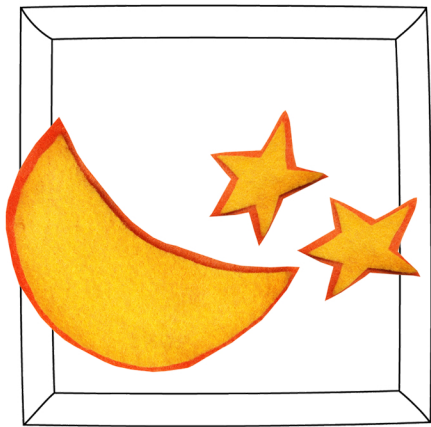
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### 7 Days of Creation

Print, laminate, and cut along the outside black lines.

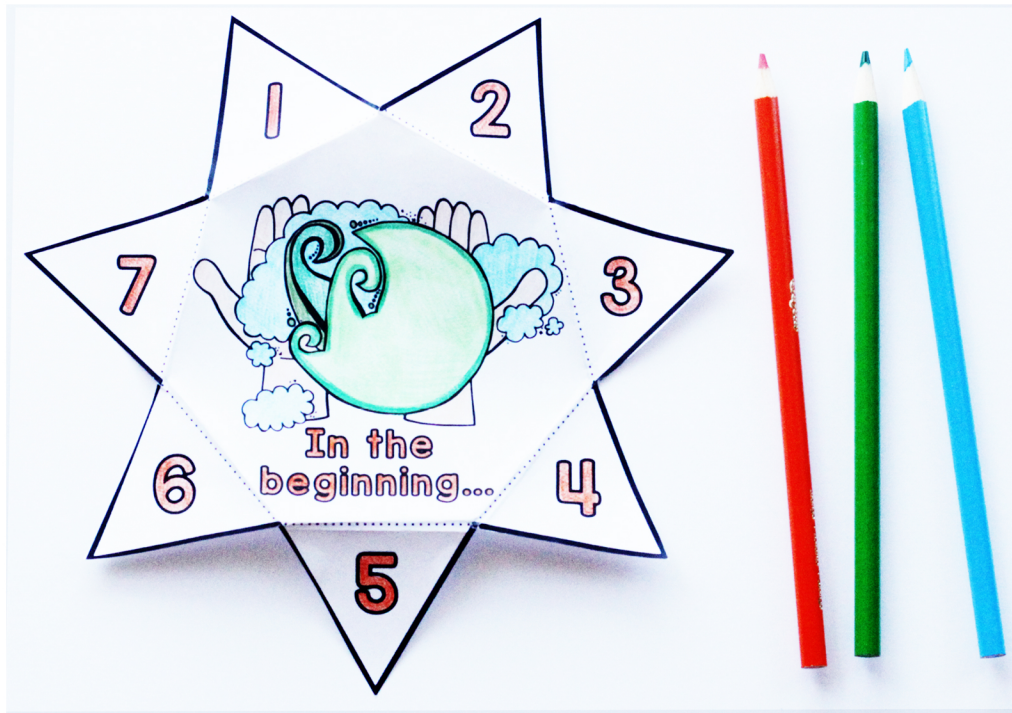
Then have fun matching the numbers to the coordinating image(s) representing the events of each day of creation.
